Tips for Rodent Prevention in the Home:

- If trash bags must be kept in the home for any period of time, store them in plastic or metal trash containers with tight-fitting, secured lids.
- Do not store any trash in areas where mice are frequently spotted, such as under the sink.
- Clean up after pets daily. Do not leave pet food out overnight and store pet food bags in sealed metal or plastic containers.
- Defrost food items in the refrigerator or microwave, not open on kitchen countertops.
- Do not leave dirty dishes and utensils or standing water sitting in the sink.
- Clean up any spilled water or food immediately.
- Avoid stacking and storing newspapers and cardboard boxes. Boxes which must be retained should be broken down so they do not present attractive nesting places for pests.
- Clothing and fabric items should be stored in sealed plastic containers, not in trash bags or loose on the floor.
- Notify landlord of any holes in the walls which appear to be caused by mice or allowing easy access to the apartment, particularly in the kitchen and bathroom areas.
